Abergavenny Market Hall is a lively and bustling market in the centre of Abergavenny. Located in the heart of town, Abergavenny market is the life and soul of the town.



When open, market stalls are run by private traders.

- Tuesday – Wednesday: 08:00 – 16:00
- Friday – Saturday: 08:00 – 16:00
- General Market: Tuesdays, Fridays and Saturdays
- Flea Market: Every Wednesday
- Craft Fair: Every 2nd Saturday (March – December)
- Farmers Market: Every 4th Thursday

Local Transport Links:

Bus Stops are available along Lion Street, within 0.1 miles of the main entrance and along the A40, within 0.2 miles of the main entrance.

Abergavenny Bus Station is 0.3 miles away.



Parking:

The **Brewery Car Park** is positioned behind the Market Hall, which vehicles can enter through Lion Street.

- This car park is paid, for a maximum of 2 hours.
- Accessible bays are provided.
- Blue Badge holders have free parking in any bay.
- The route towards the theatre along Market Street is sloped, and in excess of 50m from the main entrance.
- This car park is closed on Tuesdays.



Bus Station Car Park offers long term stay and is access by the A40.

- Accessible bays are provided.
- Blue Badge holders have free parking in any bay.

Drop off to the front of Market Hall can be requested; however, Cross Street is closed to vehicle access between 10:00 and 16:00.


On-Street accessible parking bays are provided on Cross Street, dropped kerbs are not directly available to the pedestrian pathway.

Pedestrian Routes

- Cross Street features pedestrian pathways with widths greater than 1200mm. A slight incline is along this route.
- If approaching from Market Street, pathways narrow to 880mm.
- Although new vehicle access to Cross Street is prevented between 10:00 – 16:00, vehicles may leave via Market Street. Pedestrians using the road should beware of potential oncoming traffic.



Pedestrian Routes



Entrances:

- The main entrance on Cross Street is in excess of 1500mm.
- This entrance is powered, and sensor operated.
- These doors are sliding action.
- When the market is closed, these doors will be blocked.
- A further set of lobby doors are provided. These are sensor operated.
- Both entrance and lobby doors are glazed.



Main Entrance

The Market Hall is one, main hall on one level. Stepped or lift access are not required.



Main Routes

- Floor surfaces in Market Hall are paved and uneven in some areas.
- The central route in Market Hall is in excess of 3 meters.
- Widths between market tables is approximately 1440mm.
- There are structural columns for the building, these are painted blue.
- Gazebos are used by some traders. The structures are narrow and lack contrast.
- Some areas of flooring feature bold patterns.



General WC Facilities

- WC facilities are available for traders only in the Market Hall.
- General WC facilities are available approximately 30 meters behind the Market Hall.
- Hand washing and drying facilities are sensor operated.
- A single step is provided to the General WC entrances.
- The WC facilities can be located with these What3Words:
 - Female Facility: blasted.sunbeam.shepherdess
 - Male Facility: offers.magazines.grades



Accessible WC Facilities

- An accessible WC facility is provided approximately 30 meters behind the Market Hall.
- A ramped surface leads towards the Accessible WC.
- The compartment is approximately 2196mm by 1500mm.
- The direction of transfer onto the toilet is from the right.
- A cord alarm system is available.
- A RADAR key system is required to gain access.
- The Accessible WC can be located with these What3Words:
 - dunk.engrossed.takeover



Lighting

- Lighting levels are good in the Market Hall.
- The immediate lobby features slightly low-level lighting.

Services and Facilities



- Benches are available on Market Street and Cross Street, some with armrests.



Acoustics

- The Market Hall is a large, open space.
- No quiet areas are provided.
- Induction loop systems are not available.

Further information

- The fire alarm system is audio.
- Emergency evacuation procedures for disabled visitors are provided.
- There are two, level access exit doors to the rear of the Market Hall, that lead to the outdoor Market when open.
- These doors are powered, sensor operated with sliding action.
